

# THE FOWLIE RETREAT FAQ's

# 1. How many Bedrooms / Bath and what's the layout?

We have 3 bedrooms / 2 full bath on one section of the cottage. In addition, we have a large separate room off the living room that is perfect for a rec room or separate sleeping area (14 x 20') complete with two pull out couches and large screen tv. Also, for a small additional charge we have a separate bunkie complete with two double beds.

#### 2. What's available in the Kitchen?

Everything but a dishwasher. Fully equipped kitchen with microwave, dishes, pots/pans, cutlery, cooking utensils, coffee maker.

#### 3. What size of beds does Fowlie have?

Master bedroom – one queen. 2<sup>nd</sup> bedroom – one queen; 3<sup>rd</sup> bedroom – double bunk bed (double below, single on top. Bunkie – 2 double beds. Plus we have two pull out couches.

## 4. Do you include linens / pillows/ towels?

We ask that our renters to bring their own linens, pillows, towels. We always have extra items that can be used but please bring your own.

#### 5. Do you have a washer / Dryer?

Yes, both. Plus a clothes line outside

#### 6. What entertainment items are included with the cottage?

Satellite, Internet, movies (dvd/vhs), board games, puzzles, crafts, kayaks, horseshoe pit.

Note: Internet is only available from May through September.

#### 7. What towns are close by?

Lions Head – beautiful little town and it has everything you need. 10 minutes east of the cottage. Food, Hospital, bank, liquor, gas, restaurant, etc.

Wiarton – great town with lots of great shops. 24 Hour Foodland. Food, Hospital, bank, liquor, gas, restaurant, etc.

Tobermory – a must visit. 50Km north of the cottage.

#### 8. Do you have a BBQ and Firepit?

Yes, we have a full sized propane bbq and great firepit outside

## 9. Where do you buy firewood?

There a several places along hwy 6 to purchase wood or any town.

# 10. What else is there to do around the cottage?

Swimming, fishing, kayaking, boating, atving, cross-country skiing, snowmobiling or take in the dark skies and captivating stars. There are so many exciting things to do in the Bruce Peninsula during all 4 seasons so we do encourage you to plan in advance for some outings.

#### 11. How close is the water?

We have 135 feet of gorgeous Lake Huro shoreline and our private water access is just 40 feet from the cottage.
