

THE MCIVOR GETAWAY FAQ's

1. How many Bedrooms / Bath and what's the layout?

We have 4 oversized bedrooms/ 2 full bath. 3 bedrooms on the main floor and 1 in the basement. The basement also has a very large rec room complete with tv/dvd that is perfect for when the kids need their own space.

2. What's available in the Kitchen?

Everything but a dishwasher. Fully equipped kitchen with microwave, dishes, pots/pans, cutlery, cooking utensils, coffee maker.

3. What size of beds does Mcivor have?

We have 4 queen beds in McIvor. In addition, we do have a couple of air mattresses and some comfy couches.

4. Do you include linens / pillows/ towels?

We ask that our renters to bring their own linens, pillows, towels. We always have extra items that can be used but please bring your own.

5. Do you have a washer / Dryer?

Sorry, not at this time.

6. What entertainment items are included with the cottage?

Satellite, Internet, movies (dvd/vhs), board games, puzzles, crafts, kayaks

Note: Internet is only available from May through September.

7. What towns are close by?

Tobermory – a must visit. 17 minutes north

Lions Head – beautiful little town – 15 minutes south

8. Do you have a BBQ and Firepit?

Yes, we have a full sized propane bbg and great firepit outside

9. Where do you buy firewood?

Two lots over - close to the beach you can buy wood from Cassidy Weatherhead or there are several places along hwy 6 or in any town

10. What else is there to do around the cottage?

Visit Tobermory, Lions Head; try hiking the Bruce trail. Swimming, fishing, kayaking, boating, atving, cross-country skiing, snowmobiling or take in the dark skies and captivating stars. There are so many exciting things to do in the Bruce Peninsula during all 4 seasons so we do encourage you to plan in advance for some outings.

11. How close is the water?

You are just 150 metres to the first Lake Huron access point where you can launch a boat, fish, kayak etc.. or 240 metres to a beach area. Plus there are many other beautiful beaches to visit long the Peninsula
